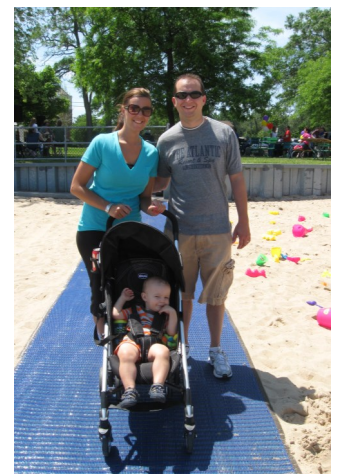
Veterans Memorial Park Beach Access Project
